Dear Highton St Lukes Sunday School,

The Russian invasion of Ukraine has created a humanitarian crisis <u>unlike anything</u> seen in Europe since World War II – and throughout the history of the Christmas Bowl.

According to the UN refugee agency, in just over a week **more than 1.5 million refugees have already fled their homes in Ukraine** to neighbouring countries. And **millions more people could become refugees,** forced from their homes and their loved ones if the fighting continues.

As you may know, we've launched an emergency appeal to support the people affected by the conflict in Ukraine and I hope that you will find time during this busy season to take part. This is a situation we must respond to together.

#### The simplest way to help is to hand out giving envelopes.

Would you **please distribute the enclosed giving envelopes** to your congregation and **take up a special offering** for the people of Ukraine devastated by this emergency?

These gifts will help support the work of the ACT Alliance, an initiative of the World Council of Churches, to provide urgently needed food, medicine and temporary shelter to displaced families.

I have written to thousands of churches across Australia. I am asking you and the members of your church to join us as we respond to Christ's call to love our neighbour.

Your congregation has been faithful and generous supporters of the Christmas Bowl and Act for Peace's work over many years. I pray that you are moved by the Spirit and heed God's call to help displaced families forced from their homes by this horrific conflict.

Our ACT Alliance partners in neighbouring Hungary have already sent truckloads of relief to support families forced from their homes by the war.



Our ACT Alliance partners on the ground distributing 28 tonnes of aid to families displaced by the war.

Much, much more is needed.

The shipments include 28 tonnes of canned food, flour, sugar, oil, rice, pasta, biscuits, long-life milk, tea and hygiene products which will be distributed at the Beregszász and Uzhhorod reception centres in Western Ukraine. But much, much more is needed.

While I know it's an incredibly busy time for churches with Lenten preparations taking place, this senseless violence in Ukraine is causing an urgent need.

I was reflecting on this week's Psalm, Psalm 91, and the words of the Psalmist really struck me, especially those in verse five.

### "You will not fear the terror of the night, or the arrow that flies by day."

Those words took on new meaning as I heard the reports from our ecumenical partners telling us of families hiding, and mothers comforting terrified children as they shelter from the missiles of invading forces. It is my prayer that these resilient people stay safe and are able to take refuge in the Lord.

If you would like to take further action as a church, please consider dedicating a service to the people of Ukraine. Our local partner, Hungarian Interchurch Aid, shared

the story of a young Ukrainian mother of three who described her family's journey to Hungary's Berehovo border crossing (you may wish to share this story with your congregation):

"My husband is on the frontlines. The women of my family have decided to take our children away from danger. By the time we were leaving Kherson we heard that Dnipro was being bombed so we had to take a different way.

My children were asking where are we going and I couldn't come up with an answer.

We heard that the Polish border is completely jammed, so we decided to cross the mountains and try to make it into Hungary.

My sister is still on the way, I have no idea where she or my nieces are."



Antonia\* (10) holds Galyna\* (3) at the Ukrainian-Hungarian border on 2nd March, 2022. Antonia fled with her family from near the Crimean Peninsula. She brought with her one toy and a colouring book, which she has already given to another child who had no toys at all.

Sadly, this story is far from unique. Hundreds of thousands more families will need urgent help as they are forcibly displaced from their homes in Ukraine.

We at Act for Peace condemn this invasion, and our hearts are with the people of Ukraine and Russia who have been suddenly caught in a war they didn't want, or even believe was possible.

It's too soon to know what will happen, but I do know that Act for Peace is working closely with our ecumenical partners on the ground who remain committed to serving the people affected. And that right now, they need our help to support families forcibly displaced by this crisis.



In just over a week, more than 1.5 million refugees, like these on the platform of Lviv railway station on 27th February, have fled Ukraine to neighbouring countries, taking the few belongings they could carry.

Please pray for those impacted by this conflict and Act for Peace's partner on the ground who is working to provide the practical and emotional support these families so desperately need.

Thank you for your faithful prayers and compassion during this difficult time.

## EMERGENCY APPEAL: UKRAINE CRISIS BANKING INSTRUCTIONS

Thank you for taking part in the Ukraine Crisis appeal in your church. If you collect gifts and would like to send them in as a collection from your church, please follow the instructions below. You can also contact our team at 1800 025 101 or info@actforpeace.org.au

## STEP 1: How to sort your gifts

For giving envelopes that have been returned to you with a cheque or credit card details, please send these back to us intact in the envelope provided, so we can record the details and provide a tax receipt to each person for their gift.

For giving envelopes that have been returned to you that contain cash, and any other cash donations collected through an open plate collection, you can deposit the cash directly into our account at any ANZ branch. Alternatively you can deposit the cash into your account and then make a payment to us online or by cheque.

### 2 STEP 2: Payment of cash gifts (Choose from the following three options)

#### 1) Cheque:

Send a cheque with your completed remittance form and deposit slip payable to 'Act for Peace Ltd' and post to us at:

#### 2) Bank deposit:

Deposit the cash into our account at your local ANZ branch.

#### 3) Online transfer:

Transfer the money online to our account.

Please include the reference: helpukraine and your church's A-81922 (e.g. A-xxxxx-helpukraine) as the description in the transaction.
