A note from the Church Council Treasurer:

The ministry and mission of St Luke's has been continuing at a pace even during the time of the lockdown. Many people have remarked on the value of the online/streamed services including those not associated with our community. With the easing of restrictions, numbers at Sunday Services and Mid-week Services are slowly recovering. More regular Messy Church gatherings will recommence in the second half of 2022. The refugee ministry continues with new families arriving into Geelong on a regular basis.

There is no question that the Congregation faces serious challenges financially and part of the response will involve our two Manses. Synod and Presbytery will be working with the Congregation to enable these assets to provide income for mission. (Currently one manse is not leased out due to some maintenance issues which in itself has reduced our income.)

St Luke's has unfortunately experienced a simultaneous decline in income and an increase in expenses in recent years. Some of the causes of our drop in income include the loss of


some members, a drop in pledged giving and a decrease in the income from the hire of the church buildings due to the impact of the pandemic.

From a cost perspective inflation has continued to increase our cost base, as has increases in maintenance and insurance costs. As well as Paul we also have 2 professional part time employees, Robyn and Shaghek. We are incredibly fortunate at St Luke's to have many hardworking volunteers, the fundraising efforts via collectables and furniture sales in aid of the refugee ministry over recent times has been fantastic.
